Mr. Tate, a partner in the law firm of Haynsworth, Sinkler Boyd, P.A., is a graduate of the Law School of Harvard University and was admitted to the South Carolina Bar in 1956. He is also admitted to practice before the United States District Court for District of South Carolina, the United States Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit and the United States Supreme Court. He has been an active member of the Richland County, South Carolina and American Bar Associations. Tate has served as chairman of the Advisory Committee of the US District Court, is a member of the Advisory Committee on Rules and Procedures for the US Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit and served on the Judicial Qualifications Committee for the SC Bar. Other memberships include the South Carolina Defense Trial Attorneys' Association, the American Law Institute and the Defense Research Institute.
